1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This document aims to define SOAC service tariffs for conformity assessment bodies (CABs) established in the Member States.

These rates are applicable in the event of the use of UEMOA Member States national assessors and experts.

Tariffs are adjusted when it is necessary to turn to assessors or experts outside the Member States. In this case, SOAC sends a pro forma invoice to the CAB for prior acceptance.

For CABs established outside the Member States, adaptations may be necessary to take into account certain specificities.

Technical field: an area of technical competence established by SOAC.

Technical Unit: operational entity within an organization, bringing together a set of resources and specific personnel to a defined technical field, all forming a technically coherent whole, placed under the responsibility of a technical manager and governed by the same management system.

File application fees	The extension (within the same technical field)
	XOF 150,000 for a CAB with an extension covering between 01 and 10 parameters of the same technical field and located on the same geographical site;
	XOF 200,000 for a CAB with an extension covering between 11 parameters and more than one technical field and located on the same geographical. Subsequent assessment and renewal without modification of the scope of accreditation: free of charge.

	[(0.5 + number of days of on-site assessment) * 180,000] XOF for each assessor or expert not responsible for assessment

	Transport ticket provided by the CAB; Residence expenses provided by the CAB; Note: SOAC defines the travelling conditions applicable to its assessors & experts on mission.
